MAR CHERI COMMUNITY CLUB 2016 SWIMMING POOL RULES

Pool Hours: 8:00 AM – 9:00 PM Memorial Day – Labor Day (may be extended at discretion of the Board of Directors)

> *** You must use your KEYCARD to enter the pool area *** Replacement cards are \$50.

All persons using the pool/pool area and play area do so at their own risk. The Mar Cheri Community Club (HOA). assumes no responsibility for any accident or injury in connection with such use or for any loss or damage to persons or property. Entry constitutes agreement not to hold the HOA, nor its agents or employees liable for personal injury or loss or damage to persons or property.

- 1. WARNING! NO LIFEGUARDS ON DUTY. SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK.
- 2. All members in good standing and with signed liability release form shall be permitted to use the pool. Keycards will be activated for use once the liability release form is signed and returned to the HOA. **All adult members (18+) of the household must sign the liability release and acknowledge receipt of pool rules.**
- 3. Make sure the access gate is closed behind you, and do not allow others in. All members must use their keycard to access the pool area.
- 4. At least one parent or designated caretaker must be at the pool with their children. Unaccompanied children may not be in the pool area, whether swimming or not. Caretakers must be eighteen (18) years of age, or older, and have written notification submitted to the Board of Directors by a parent or legal guardian. One adult may supervise a maximum of four (4) children.
- 5. Each member family may bring up to four (4) guests per day. Residents are directly responsible for their guests' actions and must remain on pool premises at the pool with their guests.
- 6. Rule violations will result in a suspension of pool privileges.
- 7. Proper swimming attire is required. Cut-off jeans and street clothes are not allowed in the pool. Children under 3 years of age must wear swim diapers.
- 8. The access gate is to be kept closed during regular pool hours and locked at all times when the pool area is not in use. The last member leaving the pool is responsible for checking the area and being sure the gate is closed.
- 9. Swimming with an open sore or communicable disease is prohibited.
- 10. The telephone at the pool is for emergencies only. NO EXCEPTIONS!
- 11. The pool should be cleared immediately in the event of thunderstorms, which include thunder and/or lightening.
- 12. No running, diving, pushing, dunking or rough play in the pool or pool area. Sitting or standing on another person's shoulders is not permitted. Flips from the side of the pool are prohibited. Jumping off backwards or in any way that throws the head back towards the side of the pool is prohibited.

- 13. Be respectful. No offensive language, loud music, intoxicants, smoking or littering. Use trash and recyclable containers. No persons are permitted to cause a disturbance to neighbors or disturb other patrons.
- 14. No pets are allowed in the pool area.
- 15. Bobby pins and other loose hair items must be removed prior to entering the pool.
- 16. All glass bottles, jars, breakable, or sharply pointed objects and fireworks are prohibited on the premises. Bringing any of these items into the pool area will result in immediate expulsion.
- 17. Everyone must take a cleansing shower before using the pool.
- 18. Pool games (such as Minnow, Marco Polo, or any ball game) are not permitted unless they do not interfere with other swimmers.
- 19. The storage and equipment doors are to remain closed and locked.
- 20. Be considerate. All noise must be curtailed before 8:00 P.M.
- 21. The Mar Cheri Community Club is not responsible for the loss of personal property.
- 22. ABSOLUTELY No Trespassing. Individuals caught in the pool area after hours will result in pool key suspension of the residence for the remainder of the season and trespassing charges filed against him or her.
- 23. Absolutely no food is allowed on the lounge deck or in the water, with the exception of plastic water bottles. All beverages (except water), snacks or other food items must be consumed at either the picnic table or the umbrella table. The only exception to this would be during an approved Mar Cheri social function.
- 24. Climbing of the fence around the pool or play area will result in immediate expulsion from the pool and loss of pool and play area privileges.
- 25. Remove the solar cover properly. Specific instructions are posted on the bulletin board. Improper removal damages the cover and makes it impossible to put it on without help.
- 26. Please report infractions, damage, trespassing, vandalism or criminal activities to a board member as soon as possible.

One keycard will be issued to each member household in good standing. The cards will be activated for use once the liability release form is signed and returned to Mar Cheri Community Club. Replacement cards are \$50. If you sell your home, give the keycard to the new owners.
